




Antidotes for Healing the Human Body



The Blood

Spiritual Correspondence

“For the life of all flesh is in the blood.”

Leviticus 17:11a

The blood corresponds to the life of God within us. We could not live without the Spirit of life flowing through our blood. The commandment to love God first governs the blood, for loving God first is the sole purpose of our very lives. Jesus clarified this when He said, “And this is life eternal, that they might know thee, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.”ⁱ Life is about knowing who God is. Living His truth taps us into His life-giving energies which purifies our blood and makes us completely whole: every whit.

All of the blood cells are speaking and communicating within our bodies. Every emotion, every thought, and every situation that we encounter is being recorded in our blood: how we felt, and what we experienced. This is because the Spirit of life, who knows all things, is housed within our blood. Our blood has a voice and is a living essence of all of our emotions and thoughts. We see this revealed in Genesis, when God spoke to Cain, who had murdered his brother, Abel:


“The voice of thy brother’s blood

Spiritual Causes of Blood Diseases

Untrue ideas about God that have become part of our lives pollute the blood. Denial of God, His laws, and our responsibility to them fills our minds and bodies with error. Blood diseases result because truth is being mixed with error. These diseases can stem from a present mind-set

or a past lifestyle, or they can be inherited through the genes from the behaviors of our ancestors, which have become part of our lives.


If blood diseases are inherited, the genes passed down to us contain the character weaknesses of those who have made a lifestyle of denying God through erroneous thinking and behavior. This behavior over time breaks down the genetic structure in our blood lines and makes us accessible to it when we succumb to similar attitudes and behaviors in our lives. Living in error allows for self-indulgent behavior; there is no life from God within it. Those who reject God's principles and live contrary to them not only reject God and His life, they unknowingly create within themselves the breakdown of their own immune systems. When good and evil are mixed together, the power of God becomes diluted, resulting in uncleanness that manifests correspondingly as blood diseases. It is the truth that can purge us and produce a greater influx of the Spirit of life within us.

Jesus left us an example of how to apply the truth so that we could do it too. Living this way empowers us with a heavenly life. His miracles were a demonstration of what is common in heavenly life, and He demonstrated it to show that it's possible for us to attain it while we are in human flesh on earth. He invited us to follow His pattern by making our natural minds spiritual. We do this by being aware of our choices of good and evil in our daily walk. By shunning evil and error, we find out who God really is, and who we are, as well. We find a treasure that is hidden in our field. This is the reward of a God-centered life. The Spirit of God will progressively lead us out of ego-centered lives into a life of divine usefulness. As the Spirit of wisdom so aptly put in the book of Proverbs:

“Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.

For whoso findeth me findeth life,
and shall obtain favor of the LORD.

But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul:
all they that hate me love death.”ⁱⁱⁱ

The Spirit of wisdom will transform our minds into spiritual ones by helping us identify what is unlike God within us. When we identify these negative habits, we can use the power of truth to speak to these habits as a separate entity and cast them out, as Jesus did. He referred to them as devils, demons, and unclean spirits. When He spoke to them, they had to leave, and angels replaced them. In this way, negative life patterns that resulted in sicknesses and diseases were removed, and His life entered people to strengthen and heal them. Putting this truth into practice as Jesus did not only elevates our minds, it also energizes every cell in our bodies, invigorating our blood with life from the Spirit of God. We become clean by implementing Jesus’s words, as we are reminded in John:


“Now ye are clean through the word
which I have spoken unto you ...

If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you,
ye shall ask what ye will,
and it shall be done unto you.”^{iv}

Separating error from our lifestyles will help restore the power of God back into our lives and our blood. This is done by looking for areas where we have refused to acknowledge God, His reality, and the application of truth. What areas of our lives do we not want God to be a part of? Addressing them will help us to see the wrong motivations that have been controlling us.

Once we see them, we can talk to God about it. By using Jesus's name, we can cast out the negative thoughts and actions and replace them with the opposite, angelic qualities. This will fill us with a greater love for ourselves and the truth. The Word of God has restorative power when error is identified and removed from our lives. Understanding what is good and evil can only be revealed from the light of truth. When we use the truth to change our negative actions, our spirit (and blood) can be purified from the root. The Lord will then show us the best road to take regarding our natural health care.

“I call heaven and earth to record this day against you,
that I have set before you life and death,
blessing and cursing: therefore choose life,
that both thou and thy seed may live:
that thou mayest love the LORD thy God, and that
thou mayest obey his voice,
and that thou mayest cleave unto him:
for he is thy life, and the length of thy days.”^v
